Step by Step Instructions to fill online scholarship form:

- 1. Open the NSP portal at https://scholarships.gov.in/ in the web browser.
- 2. Click on the Applicant Corner and go to new registration (Fresh Applications).
- 3. Fresh applicants have to complete the registration process first.
- 4. After registration students will receive the application number and password on the registered mobile number (students are directed to save the application number and password for future use).
- 5. Once registered, and then enter your login details in the applicant corner (Fresh/Renewal) respectively.
- 6. After login the student needs to fill the personal and academic details in the scholarship form (please fill all credential strictly as per matriculation certificate).
- 7. Pre-filled bonafied students certificate is to be downloaded and the hardcopy (printout) is to be duly attested/verified by the Principal.
- 8. In the second phase students have to select the respective scholarship scheme as per the eligibility criteria and thereafter upload the scanned documents and submit the application.
- 9. The application form filled is to be finally submitted with scholarship committee with photocopy of all the respective documents duly self-attested by applicant.

- 4. HP Bonafide certificate

- 7. Category certificate (SC/ST/OBC/EWS/BPL/IRDP/Minority/Disability etc.)
- 8. Latest College Admission Fee slip
