#### **4.6. ii Adequate Toilets as Per Students Strength**

4. Furthermore, there are six separate toilets on the campus exclusively for student use, ensuring privacy and convenience with separate facilities for boys and girls.

This added capacity meets the demands of the student population, reducing wait times and enhancing overall accessibility. With these washroom facilities thoughtfully distributed throughout the campus, the college ensures a clean, well-maintained, and convenient environment that caters to the needs of its community, while promoting hygiene and sustainability.



#### 4.6. iii Sanitary napkins vending machine and incinerator
