



1. Preamble

- Provide qualified faculty and academic support.
- Design and deliver structured coaching programs.
- Supply relevant study material and academic inputs, wherever feasible.
- Maintain quality and academic standards during the sessions.

6. Financial Arrangement

- The financial terms, if any, regarding fees or concessions for students shall be mutually decided.
- Preference shall be given to free or subsidized coaching for needy and meritorious students and weaker section of the society students as per mutual consent.

7. Duration of the MoU
